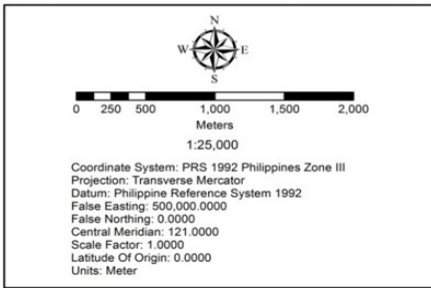

Foreword

Marikina City Government endeavors consistent updating of Marikina FACTS AND FIGURES HANDBOOK to ensure accessible and reliable resource information of the city.

This handbook features annually updated and generated core social, fiscal and economic, and environmental statistics. The data in this handbook shows Marikina's economic and population changes, trends, growth and challenges in the recent years.

The presented baseline data and community profile of the city are essential in making population projections helpful in creating governance strategies and policies responsive to labor and employment, education, health, housing, transportation, and safety and peace concerns.

The Marikina's Facts and Figures handbook in the latter years have assisted market and academic researches which were contributory to community and industry development and it will continue to do so in the spirit of good governance.

Chapter I . Experience Marikina

Marikina's History and Narratives

Marikina's journey toward urbanization and into its current status as a first class Philippine city and among the top 20 highest earning local government units in highly urbanized cities is a tale of good governance culturalization.

The ascent started in the mid-90s when Marikina became known, locally and abroad, for its aggressive norm and perspectives, challenging innovations in community management and leadership.

Marikina is not letting up in its pursuit for the highest kind of governance for its people. Today, it is a spirited city, with a vibrant economy, responsible and disciplined citizenry and a responsive local government that puts premium on good governance, sustainable urban development and efficient public service delivery system.

Its mandate and commitment is to meet and exceed the expectations and delight of its constituents.

Walking Through Marikina's History

The Augustinians were the first to arrive at the Marikina valley in 1500, at the spot known as "Chorillo" in Barangka. Next came the Jesuits in 1630, in a place now called Jesus dela Peña (Jesus of the Rocks). Here, the Jesuits established a mission and built a chapel.

In 1687, this pueblo became a parish known as Mariquina. In 1901, with the coming of the Americans, its name officially became Marikina. The early settlers lived along the riverbanks and nearby fertile farms. With the industry of the natives, combined with the know-how of the early Chinese settlers, the farms began to produce rice and vegetables in great quantities until the valley became part of the country's most prized hacienda.

By the 19th century, hacienda Marikina was owned and administered by the Tuazon family and had become the biggest in the Philippines. For its size, natural beauty, and plentiful harvest, the hacienda was declared a mayorazgo (royal estate) by the Spanish colonial government. At one time, the estate was administered by the beautiful native lass, Doña Teresa dela Paz, who was married to a scion of the Tuason family.

By the turn of the 20th century, Marikina emerged as a town of shoemakers. Shoemaking began in 1887 through the pioneering efforts of Don Laureano "Kapitan Moy" Guevarra, assisted by Tiburcio Eustaquio, Ambrocio Sta. Ines and Gervacio Carlos.

Honed by years in shoe manufacturing, the natives had developed a work ethic that prepared them for the arrival of heavy industries in the 1950s. With the proliferation of industrial plants came waves of workers who had chosen to stay, rapidly increasing the population.

Industrialization and Urbanization

On 11 June 1901, Marikina was incorporated in the newly created Province of Rizal by Act. No. 137 of the Philippine Commission. In 1975, when the Metro Manila Commission was created under Presidential Decree No. 824, integrating four cities and 13 towns majority of which were in the province of Rizal, Marikina became part of Metropolitan Manila area.

Marikina soon became a victim of its own growth, creating a slew of problems. One of these was the deterioration of the Marikina River, which resulted from the reckless behavior of factories and squatter colonies that lined the banks.

Recovery and Renewal

Marikina jumpstarted its efforts toward recovery and renewal in 1992. Guided by a vision of creating a modern and livable city, it has successfully laid the foundation of a flourishing community.

On December 8, 1996. Marikina was proclaimed a city through Republic Act 8223. Marikina has since transformed itself from a backward community into one that boasts thriving economy and hardworking, tenacious and disciplined citizens.

Geography and Topography

Today, Marikina is a preferred destination for lakbay-aral and benchmarking by government and academic institutions, even by business and people's organizations, often lauded for its vibrant business life, highly skilled workforce, and a responsive local government.

Marikina, a lush valley bounded by mountain ranges and sliced by a river, is one of the 16 cities and a municipality comprising the Metro Manila area. It is approximately 21 kilometers away from Manila, and lies within 14° 35' latitude and 14° 41' longitude. It is bounded on the East by the Sierra Madre mountains and Antipolo City; on the West by the hills of Quezon City; on the North by San Mateo of Rizal; and on the South by Pasig City and the Municipality of Cainta. It is currently with the (2) districts and composing sixteen (16) barangays

Previously, Marikina has a total land area of approximately 2,150 hectares or 21.50 sq. kms. as certified by the Bureau of Lands Management (BLM). However, in the recent cadastral surveys undertaken by the Bureau of Lands in the year 2012 and the third quarter of 2013, Marikina has an actual land area of 2,314.37 hectares or 23.14 sq. kms. This will now be the official land area adopted by the City Government.

Since Marikina is primarily a valley nestled amid mountain ranges and rolling hills, its topography is generally characterized as flat terrain, with only a mildly sloping portion. The mildly sloping area is particularly visible in the eastern section of the city. These topographic characteristics have rendered Marikina generally suitable for urban settlements as proven by the rising number of residential, commercial and industrial center in the area in recent years.

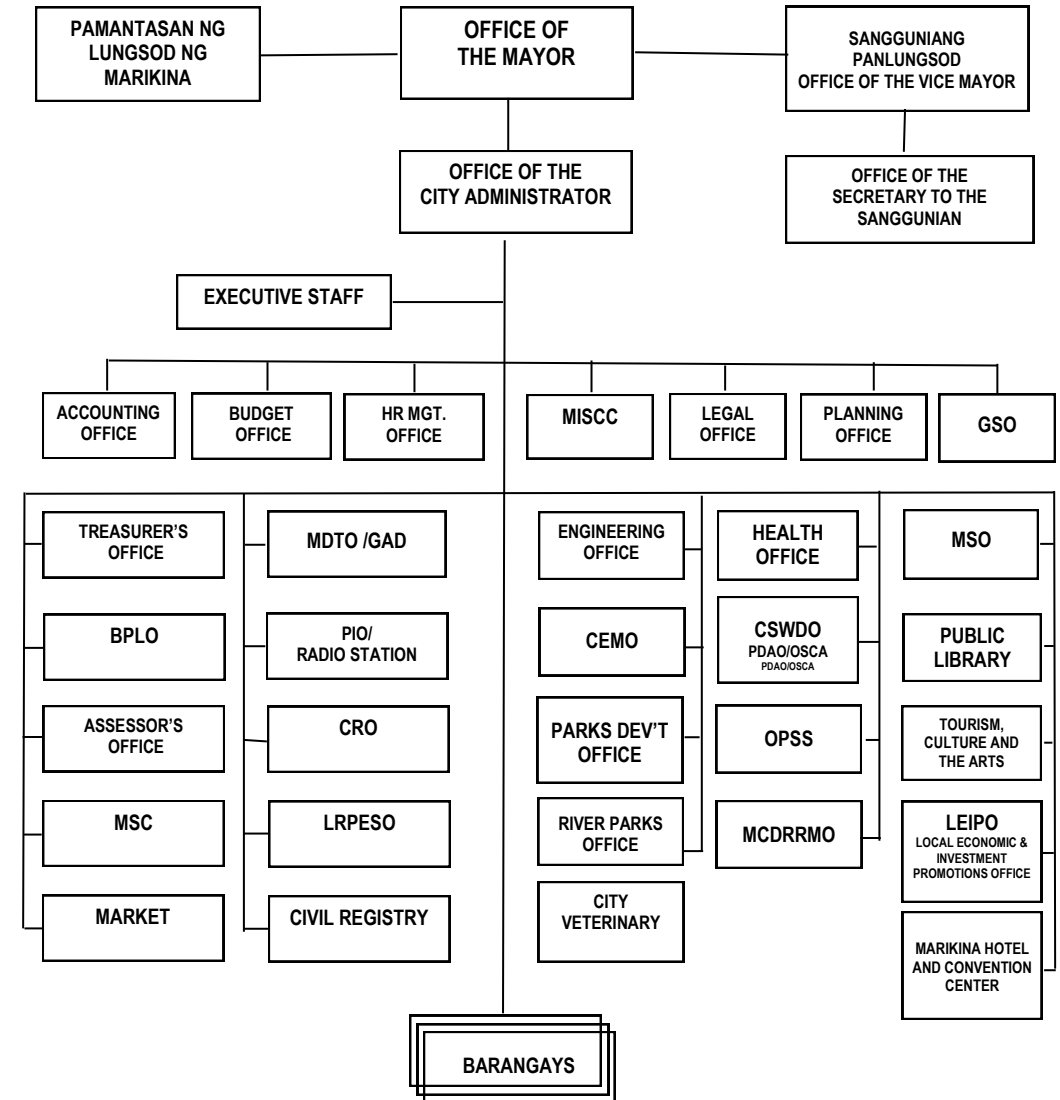
